- 2.0 College Property and Equipment: All students must take care of college equipment, facilities, and property.
- **3.0 Discipline:** SMC reserves the right to expel students for serious breaches of discipline.
- 4.0 Course Entry Requirements: International students must meet the following criteria to enroll in SMC programs:
 - Be at least 16 years of age at the course commencement date.
 - Meet specific course entry requirements.
 - Satisfy English language proficiency requirements, which include:
 - Completion of at least 50% of any AQF Certificate IV or Diploma qualification in Australia.
 - o IELTS band score of 5.5 or equivalent.
